

**NOTICE OF FILING OF AN APPLICATION UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR'S
PERMANENT LABOR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

Purpose of Notice of Filing

This notice is provided in compliance with 20 C.F.R. § 656.10(d) as a result of the filing of an application for permanent alien labor certification, concerning the employment of one alien worker, for the position described below. This Notice of Filing will be physically posted for 10 consecutive business days. The Notice will also appear in any and all in-house media in accordance with normal recruitment procedures for similar positions. All postings will occur between 30 and 180 days before filing.

- Master's degree in Health Science or Physical Therapy
- Five years of experience as a Physical Therapist; and
- A Missouri state license.

Position duties include:

- Evaluating and treating patients using physical therapy modalities, procedures and assistive devices;
- Developing plans of care directed at achieving patient goals and rehabilitation objectives;
- Participating in the strategic planning of rehabilitative services;
- Supervising and training department assistants and technicians; and
- Assisting the department director in maintaining accurate patient care records and departmental statistics.

Rate of pay:

\$63,918 per year

The employer will pay or exceed the prevailing wage as determined by the State Workforce Agency (SWA).
